Year 1/2 Money, Money, Money!

- To understand about the role money plays in their lives including how to manage their money, keep it safe, choices about spending money and what influences those choices.
- To understand about change, including transitions.

Year 3/4 Money, Money, Money!

- To learn about the role money plays in their own and others lives, including how to manage their money.
- To learn about enterprise and the skills that can make someone 'enterprising'.
- To understand about change, including transitions.

PSHE Summer 2

Year 5/6 Money, Money, Money!

- To understand that resources can be allocated in different ways and that these economic choices affect individuals, communities and the sustainability of the environment.
- To recognise that there are different kinds of responsibilities towards the environment.
- To learn about enterprise and the skills that make someone 'enterprising.'
- To learn about the role money plays in their own and others lives, including how to manage their money and about being a critical consumer.
- To develop an initial understanding of the concepts of 'interest', 'loan', 'debt' and 'tax'.
