Class Dojos

To show the children how well they are doing and keep them excited and enthusiastic about their learning we use Class Dojo. This is an on line rewards system. You should have already receive a parents log in that will enable you to see how well your child is doing in school. Class DoJo is also an excellent way of communicating with your child's class teacher. Please look out for information and updates about what is happening each day.

Homework

Over the next few weeks you will start to be given different resource to help you to support your child at home.
